**Comments on IRIS Draft Assessment on RDX from

NIOSH offers the following suggested changes (in red) to Supplemental Information, Appendix A, page A-2.

Recommended Exposure Limit (REL)—1.5 mg/m³ TWA for up to a 10-hr workday during a 40-hr workweek, **short-term (15-minute) limit 3 mg/m³**

Basis: **agreed with OSHA proposed permissible exposure limit (PEL) in 1988 PEL Hearings**

Skin designation indicates potential for dermal absorption

Basis: **agreed with OSHA proposal for skin notation in 1988 PEL Hearings**
